Arriving to Zagreb

Zagreb airport is connected with the centre through ZET bus line 290 (https://www.zagreb-airport.hr/en/passengers/to-from-the-airport/by-airport-shuttle/89) which operates every 35 mins.

Another way of reaching the centre is the scheduled shuttle "Pleso transport" (https://www.zagreb-airport.hr/en/passengers/to-from-the-airport/by-airport-shuttle/89), which follows the flight timetable.

Both lines will get you to the central bus station (Autobuski kolodvor Zagreb).

Transport across Zagreb

A network of trams and buses operates in Zagreb (ZET). The tickets are sold in ZET ticket offices, at kiosks or inside the vehicle. Four types of paper tickets are available: 30, 60 and 90 mins and daily ticket (https://www.zet.hr/tickets-and-fares/paper-tickets/603). In addition to public transport, various taxy companies as well as Uber and Bolt operate in Zagreb.

Venue

Botanical garden is situated in the centre of Zagreb, 15 mins walking distance from the main Josip Jelačić Square.

It can easily be reached from the **main railway station** (Glavni kolodvor) by taking the daily tram lines 2 (direction: Črnomerec), 4 (direction: Savski most) or 9 (direction: Ljubljanica) and travelling for one stop (stop: Botanički vrt). This ride will take 5-7 mins, while the walking distance is 10 mins.

The venue can also be reached from the **central bus station** (Autobusni kolodvor Zagreb) by taking the daily tram line 2 (direction: Črnomerec) and travelling for 4 stops (stop: Botanički vrt). The ride takes 15 mins, while the walking distance is 24 mins.



The entrance/exit to the Botanical garden is possible through main gate (red arrow) and the side gate (dashed red arrow), situated in the northern part. The conference will be held in the **Botanical Garden Pavilion** (red square), situated in the eastern part of the Garden, which can be reached through the walking paths (green-dotted lines).



IMPORTANT VENUE INFO!

During the Conference, the Garden will NOT be fully open for public. During times when the Garden is closed, we will ensure the entry/exit through the side gate (dashed red arrow). During the entry/exit into the Garden, please have your accreditation with you (prior to registration identify yourself to the Garden staff as ECCB participant). During your the Garden, we kindly ask you to follow the Garden rules all times stay in at (https://botanickivrt.biol.pmf.hr/en/garden-rules/).

The Garden is open for public 9:00 - 14:30 (Tuesday) and 9:00 - 19:00 (Wednesday). When the Garden is not open for public, we kindly ask you not to take unsupervised tours around the garden. By all means leave the Garden until 19:00, as it will be locked until the next morning.

Pocket guide to the Botanical garden (EN) is available for sale (price: 10 HRK≈1,3 eur) at the main gate.

Money and payment

The currency in Croatia is Croatian kuna (HRK) and payments in euro are not possible. The approximate middle exchange rate is 7.55 kunas for 1 euro. Shops and restaurants mostly accept payment by debit or credit cards.

Lunch breaks

Given the fact that you have two hours on your disposal, and that you are in the very centre of the City, you can choose within walking distance from pizza cut for little less than 2 Euros to nice raw steak for several hundreds of Croatian kunas.


Excursions (departure 8:00 – return 19:00)

Departure for both excursions is 8:00, please be there 10 mins earlier. The bus will depart from **Mimara museum**, located 7 mins walking distance from the main entrance of the Botanical garden.

Please prepare yourself adequately for the fieldtrips – they will include mountaineering and crossing lakes in boats. Before each fieldtrip you will receive a sandwich and a bottle of water (0.5L) in the bus. Lunch is organized at the end of both fieldtrips (Risnjak at cca 16:00, Plitvice at cca 15:00).

Both areas are protected by Croatian law (National Parks) therefore collecting of material is not allowed without a permit.
